We hope this journal will enhance scientific cultural life on individual KPTIP member campuses as well as among the several local and international universities comprising KPTIP. This consortium is striving to have an accredited journal, drawing on the dedication and loyalty to scientific inquiry of those working in member higher education institutions. We carry a responsibility to disseminate and share knowledge with general and academic audiences, thereby building the intellectual life of higher education in Indonesia and abroad.
